All you need to know about your stay in Kampala, Uganda

This info pack will shed light on a number of vital elements that range from international diplomatic relations with other countries to internal security concerns for both local and visiting participants.

The details provided in this document are solely meant for foreign travelers coming to Uganda and especially for the UbuntuNet-Connect Conference happening on 26th and 27th October 2023. Neither RENU, UbuntuNet Alliance nor the organizing committee of the conference will be held responsible for anyone who uses this information for any other reasons besides attending the Conference on the scheduled dates.

Travel Regulations and Requirements

VISA Applications

All persons intending to travel to Uganda for holiday, tourism, business, study, visit, and/or medical are required to apply and obtain a visa online. Applications should be filled out at the following link. The application should be made at the earliest possible since the application undergoes a series of reviews from the immigration officers before being accepted. Please note that the following countries are visa-exempt; Angola, Eritrea, Malawi, Madagascar, Seychelles, Swaziland, Zambia, Comoros, Kenya, Mauritius, Zimbabwe, Tanzania, Rwanda, Burundi, Antiqua, Barbados, Fiji, Grenada, Lesotho, Sierra Leone, Solomon Islands-The Grenadines, Vanuatu, Ghana, Cyprus, Bahamas, Belize, Gambia, Jamaica, Malta, Singapore, St. Vincent-Tonga.

Passports

All individuals intending to travel to Uganda will need passports to enable their entry. The passport should be valid for a minimum period of 6 months from the date of entry into Uganda



Currencies

The local currency used in Uganda is the 'Uganda Shilling'. However, a number of International currencies are acceptable, especially in well established businesses. These currencies are the US Dollar, The British Pound and the Euro. Other currencies can be exchanged at dedicated forex bureaux within the country. The exchange rates are solely determined by the Forex Bureau and may change without any warning.

Card Transactions

For travelers using cashless methods, Mastercard and VISA cards are acceptable especially in established hotels, supermarkets, and shops.


Local Taxi Services




There are two Local service firms in Uganda that are widely used and recognized, these are Uber and Safeboda/Safetaxi. These are operated via an App installed on one's phone both Android and IOS operating systems. Use the links to download SafeBoda and Uber.

Tour guides and travels

A number of tourist destinations exist in Uganda. Individuals intending to take time and tour the country can find the details on one of Uganda's oldest travel companies, <u>Uganda Travel Bureau</u> to book a slot. All travelers are advised to carry a type G adapter for seamless use of their personal electrical appliances. See the image below.





Weather

Generally, October in Uganda is usually pleasantly warm, humid but cool. With temperatures ranging between 26OC to lows of 19OC. To find more about the weather forecasts. Please use <u>BBC Weather</u> or the UNMA <u>Website</u>. It's important to note that Uganda National Meteorological Association (UNMA) offers a quarterly forecast, regular updates are uploaded to the site every after a given interval. It is therefore vital to keep checking the site and different verified social media channels of Uganda's media houses for more on the climate and weather updates.

Health and Safety

Hospitals, Pharmacies and General Clinics

Medical facilities can be accessed all around the Conference venue from established medical centres such as Kiruddu National Referral Hospital. Other nearby hospitals include International Hospital Kampala, Namuwongo which is within 20 minutes from the conference venue.

A number of pharmacies for general prescriptions are established within Munyonyo. However, a few of them offer delivery services. These include First Pharmacy, Rocket Health and Ecopharm which can be accessed through the websites below;

Police Stations

Medical Requirements

Yellow Fever Vaccine


The Government of Uganda through the Ministry of Health is committed to protecting the population from the risk of importing or further spreading the Yellow Fever virus by establishing entry and exit requirements on Yellow Fever Vaccination for travelers.

Proof of vaccination is often required for travelers arriving from countries with risk of Yellow Fever transmission and sometimes for travelers in transit through such countries.

Accordingly, in line with International Health Regulations, Uganda abides by World Health Assembly resolutions on the requirement for Yellow Fever vaccination for travelers thus;

- 1. Yellow Fever vaccination certificate is a requirement for persons travelling from endemic countries to Yellow Fever free countries.
- 2. It is not a requirement for travelers to receive booster doses after the one-time vaccination which gives lifelong protection.

Covid-19



Anyone arriving to Uganda will be required to present a negative PCR test, no older than 72 hours. Ensure to carry a face mask for your safety and others. More details can be accessed on the Ministry of Health website.

Restaurants

Uganda currently has two popular telecom companies that offer mobile services within and outside the Country. These are MTN and Airtel Uganda. However, a wide range of internet service providers exist in the country.
