Travel Regulations and Requirements

VISA Applications

All persons intending to travel to Tanzania for holiday, tourism, business, study, visit, and/or medical are required to apply and obtain a visa online. Applications should be filled out at the following link. The application should be made at the earliest possible since the application undergoes a series of reviews from the immigration officers before being accepted.

COUNTRIES THAT ARE VISA EXEMPT;

Passports

All individuals intending to travel to Tanzania will need passports to enable their entry. The passport should be valid for a minimum period of 6 months from the date of entry into Tanzania



Currencies

The local currency used in Tanzania is the 'Tanzania Shilling'. However, a number of International currencies are acceptable, especially in well-established businesses. These currencies are the US Dollar, The British Pound and the Euro. Other currencies can be exchanged at dedicated forex bureaux within the country. The exchange rates are solely determined by the Forex Bureau and may change without any warning.

Card Transactions

MasterCard and VISA cards are acceptable for travellers using cashless methods, especially in established hotels, supermarkets, and shops.

Local Taxi Services



Two Local service firms in Tanzania are widely used and recognized, these are Uber and Bolt. These are operated via an App installed on one's phone both Android and IOS operating systems. Use the links to download <u>Bolt</u> and <u>Uber</u>

Tour guides and travels

A number of tourist destinations exist in Tanzania. Individuals intending to take time and tour the country can find the details on one of Tanzania's oldest travel companies, <u>Tanzania Travel Company</u> to book a slot.

All travelers are advised to carry a type G adapter for seamless use of their personal electrical appliances. See the image below.



Weather

Generally, October in Tanzania is a relatively cool, clear and sunny month. Day time temperatures will be mild, and evenings and early mornings will be comfortably cool. The average temperature is ranging from 26.20C (790F) to 31.30C (88.4 OF). To find more about the weatherforecasts, please use <u>BBC Weather</u> or the <u>Tanzania Meteorological Authority</u>.

It's important to note that the <u>Tanzania</u> <u>Meteorological Authority</u> (TMA) offers a quarterly forecast, and regular updates which are uploaded to the site after a given interval. It is therefore vital to keep checking the site and different verified social media channels of Tanzania's media houses for more on the climate and weather updates.

Health and Safety

Hospitals, Pharmacies and General Clinics

Medical facilities can be accessed all around the Conference venue from established medical centres such as MHS-Massana Hospital and College (15 min - 7.1 km) via White Sands Road and Bagamoyo Rd), Lugalo Hospital (21 min - 9.7 km via Bagamoyo Rd). Other nearby conference venue hospitals include Muhimbili National Hospital and Rabininsia Memorial Hospital.

A number of pharmacies for general prescriptions are established within Dar es Salaam near the Conference venue. However, a few of them offer delivery services. These include KV Pharmacy, Nakiete Pharmacy, Omio Pharmacy and Kemil Pharmacy which can be accessed through the websites/social media pages below;

Police Stations

Local police stations are established in various locations to ensure accessibility to law enforcers in cases of emergency. The <u>coordinates</u> to the nearest police station from the UbuntuNet Connect 2024 Conference venue.

Medical Requirements

Yellow Fever Vaccine

The Government of Tanzania through the Ministry of Health is committed to protecting the population from the risk of importing or further spreading the Yellow Fever virus by establishing entry and exit requirements on Yellow Fever Vaccination for travelers.

Proof of vaccination is often required for travelers arriving from countries with a risk of Yellow Fever transmission and sometimes for travelers in transit through such countries.

Accordingly, in line with International Health Regulations, Tanzania abides by World Health Assembly resolutions on the requirement for Yellow Fever vaccination for travelers thus;

- 1.A Yellow Fever vaccination certificate is a requirement for persons travelling from endemic countries to Yellow Fever free countries.
- 2. It is not a requirement for travelers to receive booster doses after the one-time vaccination which gives lifelong protection.

Covid-19

You are not required to present proof of vaccination against COVID-19 or a negative result. Find out more <u>here</u>.
